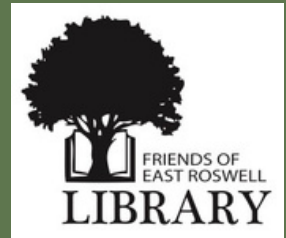

April is a wonderful time to visit the library as everything begins to bloom—inside and out. There's something for everyone to discover this season.

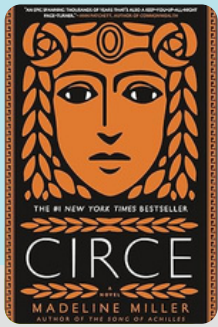

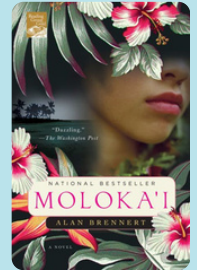
